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New ways of working – challenges and change (Danny Keenan)

Challenges:

1. Timely data (challenging) versus yearly assured data
2. Routine data collection to reduce burden (electronic systems)
3. Metrics which allow benchmarking across healthcare providers and have a time sequence between years are encouraged
4. The choice of metrics should be clinician and patient led with regular review of appropriateness and performance
5. Case mix adjustment should be used when patient factors could influence the comparability across providers



New ways of working – challenges and change

Challenges (2):

6. Alignment with other system initiatives to reduce data burden and volume of recommendations eg Model health systems work
7. Projects should reduce burden by aiming for a discrete set of metrics. NCA providers with more than 20 metrics should provide a justification document for HQIP / funder review.
8. Timely data increases local quality improvement



New ways of working – challenges and change

Outputs:

1. Replace the annual report with an annual state of the nation summary (maximum 10 pages and 5 national recommendations).
2. Replace local recommendations with online improvement resources.
3. Make all audit performance metric results available in an interactive format online.
4. Refresh all audit performance metric results at least quarterly in year two, then monthly thereafter.

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Clinical Audit Hero Awards



Patient Safety Hero (clinical audits supporting improved patient safety)



Patient Advocate Hero (clinical audits effectively engaging patients)



Influencing Change Hero (clinical audits that are supporting change in healthcare practice, planning or process)



Health Inequalities Hero (clinical audits that have utilized findings to reduce health inequalities)



Future-proofing Healthcare Hero (clinical audits that are planning for or supporting practice in the future)



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Criteria for all awards

- Must involve a clinical audit(s)*
- Individuals or teams can be nominated by themselves or by others
- Projects, individuals or teams can be based in any type of health and care setting in the UK
- Those nominated must have led or made a substantial contribution to the successful delivery of the project
- Shows evidence e.g. improved patient safety
- Data collection period must have been since 1st October 2020

- Championing data-driven and evidence-based improvement as good practice
- Evidence of improvements
- Evidence of re-audit showing improvement and sustainability

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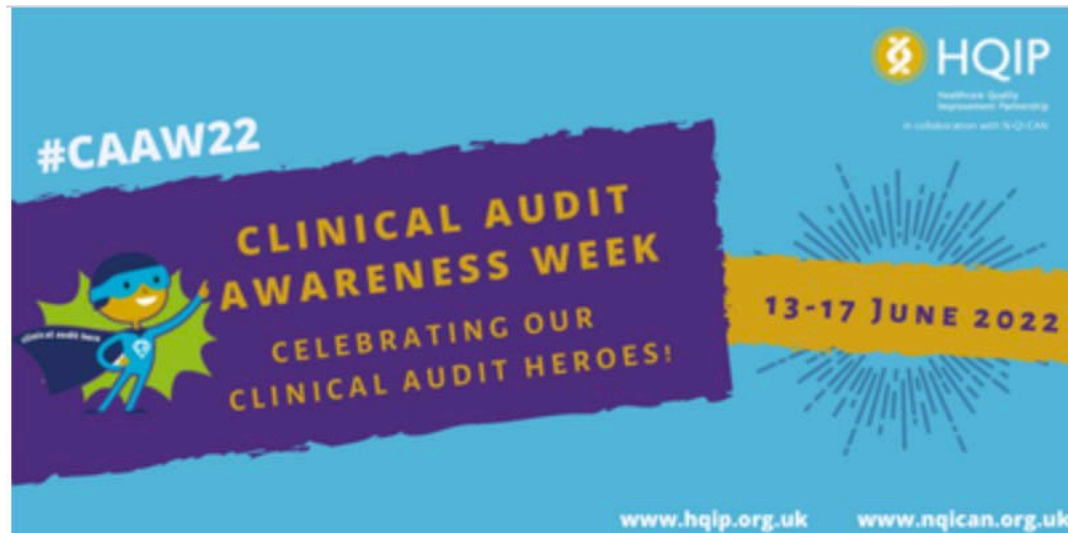
