#### At system and/or national level

- Generate better understanding, and evidence, of how change happens in complex systems, and how it can be enabled
- Identify and effectively engage with a range of stakeholders
- Gather informative insights from patients and communities (<u>our patient engagement services</u>), NHS staff or wider stakeholders
- Measure design eg Patient-Reported Experience Measures (PREMs) or Patient-Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs), evaluation frameworks and/or measurement systems.

Note: For highly-complex projects, we can partner with various national specialists to bring together multiple skillsets for a truly bespoke project.

  - Benchmarking performance (including clinical audit results and clinical outcomes measures)
